FLIGHTS

- Lusaka-Jeki/Royal – 35 minutes, typically in a Cessna 208 Grand Caravan
- Lusaka-Mfuwe – 1 hour, typically in a Jet Stream Twin Turbo Prop
- Jeki-Mfuwe – 90 minutes, typically in a Cessna 208 Grand Caravan (not always available)

TRANSFERS

- Jeki-Chiawa Camp; 15-minute game drive followed by a 45-minute speed boat ride, all in the NP.
- Royal-Chiawa Camp; 1-hour game drive of which 40 minutes is in the NP.
- Chiawa Camp-Old Mondoro; about a one-hour speed boat ride in the NP.
- Old Mondoro-Jeki; about a one-hour game drive, all in the NP.
- Mfuwe-Puku Ridge; 45-minute drive through villages plus 45-minute drive in the NP.

INCLUDES

- Flights on Proflight (schedule) between Lusaka, Lower Zambezi and Mfuwe (South Luangwa)
- 9 nights of Accommodations and choice of minimum 2 daily safari activities, transfers between camps and airfields, meals, bar, daily laundry, taxes and mandatory Park & Conservation charges.

EXCLUDES

- Tips and purchases of a personal nature
- National Park angling/fishing fees
